Re: You are entitled to the information you requested - 2025-01528-NSPHA

Nova Scotia Provincial Housing Agency received your application for access to information under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* on July 9, 2025.

In your application, you requested a copy of the following records:

Total number currently on the public housing waitlist - with a breakdown of waitlist totals for each region, unit type, and the percentage of those currently on the waitlist who are over the age of 65. Updated 2025/07/09 to amend age to those 58 and over. (Date Range for Record Search: From 7/8/2025 To 7/8/2025)

The records closest to the date requested is for June 27, 2025.

Senior applicants, those 58 and above, represent 47% of applicants on the waitlist.
